

**CITY ORDINANCE**  
**CHAPTER 113**  
**CITY OF KEEWATIN**

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 113: TOBACCO REGULATION,  
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEEWATIN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 113, Tobacco Regulation is hereby amended to add a new section 113.12 Public Use Restrictions which shall read as follows:

“§113.12 PUBLIC CANNABIS USE RESTRICTION.

(1) Cannabis Smoking Prohibitions.

- (a) By order of the City Council of the City of Keewatin, smoking marijuana or cannabis products is prohibited in the following locations:
  - i. On all public streets, public sidewalks, public easements, or within ten feet of an entrance to such building.
  - ii. In all publicly-owned or operated parking lots or parking facilities.
  - iii. On all publicly-owned property, public parks, publicly owned recreation areas and publicly-owned buildings.
  - iv. In all buildings used as a Youth-Oriented Facility or where the principle use is for youth activities.
- (b) This ordinance is intended to supplement and expand the Minnesota Clean Indoor Air Act, Minnesota Statute Sec. 144.411 to 144.417, as amended from time to time. Nothing in this ordinance authorizes smoking in any location where smoking is restricted by other applicable laws.
- (c) As used in this Section, the term “smoking” shall include the use or possession of a lighted, rolled/loose leaf or flower cannabis or its derivatives, pipe, cannabis smoking device, marijuana smoking device, or any other lighted smoking equipment intended for or actually used to smoke cannabis.
- (d) Any person violating this section of the City Code is guilty of a petty misdemeanor.”

All other provisions of Keewatin City Code Chapter 113: Tobacco Regulation shall remain as currently in existence and not amended except as specifically added herein and said amendment shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
