

Notice To City of Keewatin Residents and Commercial Public Utilities Accounts

The Cold Weather Rule protections will end on **April 30, 2026, for those residents on payment plans**. On April 30, 2026, all customers are required to have their **public utility accounts paid in full**.

To avoid service interruption, please ensure your utility bill is fully paid by the deadline. There is a disconnection fee of \$50.00 and reconnection fee of \$50.00 that will be added to your account if service interruption does occur due to unpaid public utility accounts. There will be no reminder telephone calls for past due notice for the April 25th due date.


As a renter, if you are unable to abide by this deadline, you may want to contact your landlord.
